



People



Income and Spending

Households in Davidson County earn a median yearly income of \$60,244. 25.47% of the households earn more than the national average each year. Household expenditures average \$62,729 per year. The majority of earnings get spent on Shelter, Transportation, Food and Beverages, Health Care, and Utilities.


